Ali Baba was living with his wife and a daughter in a small stone house.

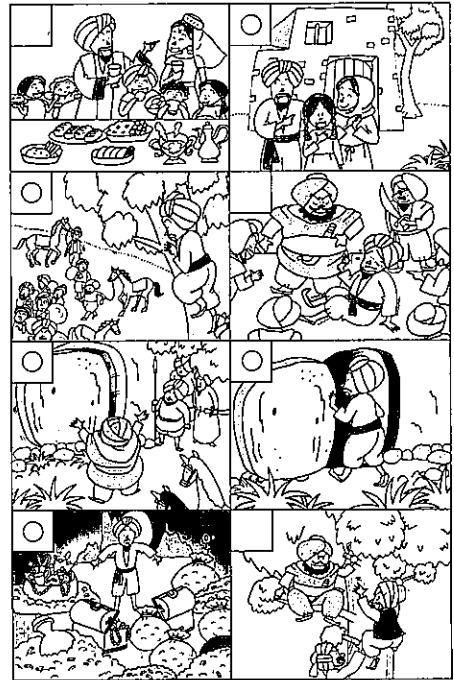
They were poor but happy.

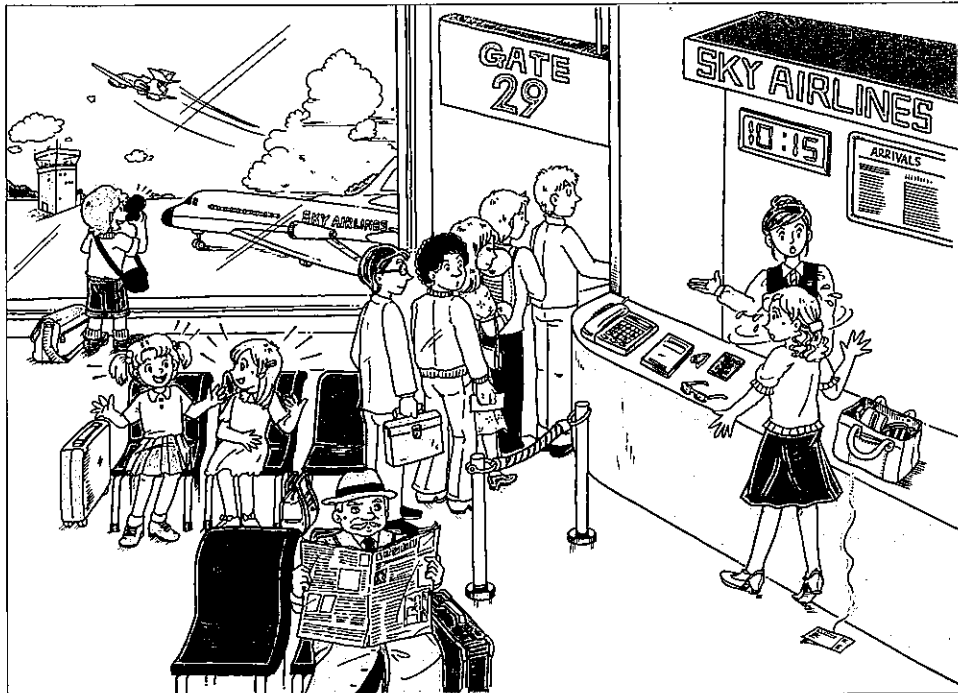
